#### AMATEUR ATHLETIC WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the Rocky Mountain Hockey League (hereafter referred to as "The League") athletic/sports program, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates and agrees that:

1. The risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
2. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the Releasees or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If however I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless the League, their officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("Releasees"), with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether arising from the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

#### LEAGUE TERMS OF REGISTRATION

1. The player represents that they have no known medical condition which would prohibit them from participating in the sport of ice hockey. **The League strongly recommends each player receive a physical check-up before beginning participation in any League event.** The player certifies that he has medical insurance in the amount of at least \$1000 or more per incident which would apply to any sports-related injury. The player acknowledges that they are responsible for all medical costs arising from injuries received while participating in League activities.
2. The player agrees that they will act in a mature and responsible manner in all League activities in which they may participate. The player understands that, as a member of the League, they represent the League to the general public. **The player acknowledges that any behavior which the management of the League shall deem to jeopardize the League's ability to lease ice or otherwise conduct its business will result in the player's immediate expulsion from the League.** The player represents that they have never been expelled from or barred from registering from any adult hockey organization for reasons of violence or other misconduct.
3. The player agrees that they will never bring any alcoholic beverage or illegal drugs on the premises of any ice skating facility. The premises of any ice skating facility shall include, but not be limited to, the team rooms, dressing rooms, warming rooms, seating or spectator areas, general grounds, and parking areas provided by the facility. The player acknowledges that they will be subject to immediate expulsion from the League for violation of this rule.
4. The player agrees to reimburse the League in full, within ten days of notice, for the cost of any property damage for which the player is held responsible by the management of the League or for which the League is billed by any ice skating facility.
5. The player agrees that the League shall have the sole authority to determine the team on which the player will be permitted to participate.
6. Any player who receives a game misconduct will be assessed an automatic one (1) game suspension. A second game misconduct during the current season will result in a two (2) game suspension. Any player who receives three (3) game misconducts during the season will be suspended for the balance of the season, including playoffs. The length of suspension for any player receiving a gross misconduct or match penalty will be determined by league administrator based on the severity of the infraction.
7. The player acknowledges that they may be expelled from the League for any of the following additional reasons: a) financial delinquency; b) failure to abide by all League rules and directives; c) falsification of registration information.
8. The League does not warrant the quality of any equipment used in any League activities. The player acknowledges that in the event that they sustain an injury as a result of a defect present in any equipment, they will not hold the League or any of the League's officials, management or owners liable for such injury.
9. The League reserves the right to refuse to register or re-register any applicant for any reason which is not in violation of applicable State and Federal laws. Further, the League reserves the right to terminate any player's participation in League activities at any time during the course of that activity, session or season, for any reason which is not of applicable State or Federal laws.
10. The player agrees that the League may use any audio and/or visual recordings or any League activity in which they may appear for promotional, advertising or education purposes.
11. The player acknowledges that they have received, and have read and understand all of the provisions of these Terms of Registration and Official Player Rules of USA Hockey, and the player agrees to be bound by and to comply with all of such provisions. The rules and regulations of the League are subject to change as published from time to time in any subsequent version(s) of the League's Terms of Registration and/or the Official Playing Rules of USA Hockey.
12. The player agrees that they shall participate in all games between League teams (whether or not such games have been officially endorsed, sponsored, or otherwise approved by the League) strictly in accordance with the then existing Terms of Registration and Official Playing Rules of USA Hockey, and the player agrees to be bound by and to comply with all sanctions and other penalties imposed by the League resulting from the conduct of such games.
13. The player acknowledges that each League team shall have a team captain who shall be elected from among the team's players promptly upon commencement of each season. The team captain shall be authorized to act as the sole agent of the team for purposes of entry into any and all obligations of the team consistent with these Terms of Registration and all other League rules and regulations, but shall not be authorized to act as the agent of individual team members on matters unrelated to League team. If the player signing these Terms of Registration shall be elected such a team captain, they shall act to insure that the team strictly complies with all League rules and regulations.
14. These Terms of Agreement and all rights and duties hereunder shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Colorado without reference to the conflict of laws.
15. The player acknowledges that the above Release of Liability/Assumption of Risk Agreement and Terms of Registration represent the entire agreement between the player and the League. There are no valid or binding representations, inducements, promises, or agreements, oral or otherwise between the player and the League that are not contained herein. These Terms of Registration are binding upon the player, their personal representative, executor, guardian, conservator, or other successor and shall survive the death or disability of the player.

**I have read this Release of Liability/Assumption of Risk Agreement and League Terms of Registration, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without any inducement.**
